Samara led the Open Museum for All initiative to bridge educational inequality by giving underserved children access to museums and cultural spaces. Grounded in India's stark learning disparities, the program addressed the reality that less than 20% of low-income children experience such environments. The initiative provided immersive, hands-on learning through visits to the National Science Museum and National Craft Museum. It exposed children from Delhi's low-income communities to art, history, and science, fostering imagination and critical thinking. Samara's efforts reaffirms her belief that learning is not a privilege reserved for a few—but a shared right for all. She aims to reach 50,000 children in the next 3 years through this program.
